




# 2006 Louisiana Health and Population Survey Survey Report November 27, 2006

# **Jefferson Parish**









#### **Project Overview**

Hurricanes Katrina (August 29, 2005) and Rita (September 23, 2005) caused extensive damage and displacement across southern Louisiana. This displacement has created great uncertainty about the population size, demographics and health status within Louisiana. As recovery progresses, timely and accurate population estimates are critical to guide decision-makers across all sectors in effective planning and efficient resource allocation.

In February 2006, the Louisiana Department of Health and Hospitals and the Louisiana Recovery Authority requested assistance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention/Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry and the U.S. Census Bureau to:

- Estimate the population size and collect health and economic information in 18 hurricane-affected parishes
- Compare survey-based population estimates with modeled estimates
- Develop a sustainable survey program to provide continuous population estimates as requested by federal, state and local authorities.

To fulfill these objectives, the 2006 Louisiana Health and Population Survey was conducted to provide state and local authorities with accurate demographic, health and economic information for public health, emergency preparedness and economic development planning. The Louisiana Public Health Institute was contracted to implement the process, oversee daily survey operations and deliver the data.

Surveys were received from Jefferson Parish between June and October 2006.

The serious psychological distress scale (K6) is a six-item scale developed to measure serious mental illness. The K6 was only asked of head of households 18 years of age and older. The answers were self-reported and no proxies were allowed. The K6 is designed to identify persons with serious psychological distress using as few questions as possible. While a score of  $\geq$ 13 indicates a serious mental health condition, the answers provided by the respondent do not represent an actual clinical diagnosis.
